TOURNAMENT FORMATS

To enhance your tournament, Eagle Springs Golf & Country Club offers several different tournament formats, which can be adapted to your specific needs. We are happy to assist you in choosing the most appropriate format for your group. Our Pro Shop will generate Team Handicap's when necessary.

INDIVIDUAL NET PLAY

Each golfer plays his or her golf ball and at the end of the round they subtract their handicap from their gross score to obtain their net score. Participants must have a current G.H.I.N. handicap for this format.

2 BEST BALL OF FOURSOME

Each Player on a four-person team plays his or her own golf ball. Golfers apply their handicap strokes to each hole and the lowest two net scores on each hole is recorded as the team score. Participants must have a current G.H.I.N. handicap for this format.

SCRAMBLE

Each player on a four-person team drives from the tee and the best shot is selected. All players then play the next shot from the position of the selected ball, placing his or her golf ball within a club length from that spot, no closer to the hole. The same procedure is used on all shots, including putts and through the completion of the hole. Calculate the total number of shots and this is your teams score. If desired a scramble can be handicapped using 12.5% of the total team handicap.

SCHAMBLE

Like a scramble, each player on a four person team drives from the tee and the best shot is selected. All players then play their individual shot from this selected position placing the ball within one club length no closer to the hole. Unlike the Scramble, from this point each player will play his or her own golf ball for the duration of the hole applying his or her own handicap to determine an individual score.



SPECIAL CONTESTS

Eagle Springs will help promote your tournament and add excitement to the game with our suggested special contests. Our staff will assist in the promotion of your tournament by posting your Tournament information and Registration with the Pro Shop, including our website at eaglespringsgcc.com.

HOLE IN ONE

A Hole-in-One insurance package may be purchased offering world class prizes, a golf vacation, a new car, a pair of Super Bowl tickets and much more. These packages guarantee winning prizes to the players, without your organization having to incur the prizes real cost. Please inquire with our Golf Operations Manager for package pricing and information. The Hole-in-One prize can vary so if you wish not to have a Hole-in-One Insurance Package as an alternative you may purchase a designated prize from our Pro Shop, including golf equipment, a hand held GPS or ESGCC golf package. We can assist you in the selection of the desired Hole-in-One prize.

CLOSEST TO THE PIN

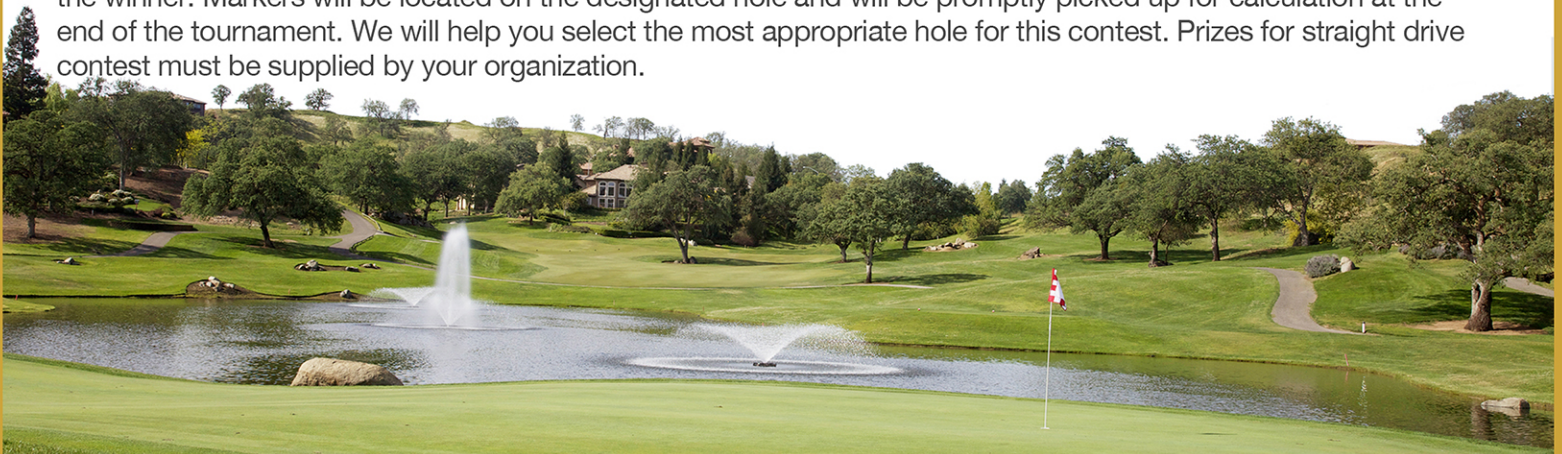
Eagle Springs will set-up closest to the pin contests for designated par three holes at **no additional charge**. The golfer whose ball lands closest to the hole is the winner. Information regarding location and yardage is available on the courses scorecard. Markers and tape measures will be located on each of the designated holes and will be promptly picked up for calculation at the end of the tournament. Prizes for closest to the pin contest must be supplied by your organization.

LONG DRIVE

Eagle Springs will set-up a long drive contest for your tournament at **no additional charge**. The golfer whose ball lands furthest from the tee, but is still inside the fairway is the winner. Markers will be located on the designated hole and will be promptly picked up for calculation at the end of the tournament. We will help you select the most appropriate hole for this type of contest. Prizes for long drive contests must be supplied by your organization.

STRAIGHT DRIVE

Eagle Springs will set-up straight drive contest for your tournament at **no additional charge**. A straight line is drawn through the center of the fairway on the designed hole. The golfer whose ball lands closest to that line is the winner. Markers will be located on the designated hole and will be promptly picked up for calculation at the end of the tournament. We will help you select the most appropriate hole for this contest. Prizes for straight drive contest must be supplied by your organization.





FUNDRAISING SUGGESTIONS

Eagle Springs is pleased to offer you valuable fundraising suggestions, which will help with raising money while adding even more excitement to your event. Our fundraising options can be factored into your tournament budget to lower your entry or can be used to raise additional funds for your organization or charity.

HOLE SPONSORSHIP

Hole sponsorship is a win-win option, providing your tournament supporters with an inexpensive way to advertise and get community exposure, while you raise money for your cause. Multiple sponsorship signs can be sold for each hole on the golf course, usually for \$100.00 - \$300.00 each.

MULLIGANS

When a golfer purchases a mulligan, they are really buying an extra shot on the golf course in hopes of lowering their total score. The typical charge for a mulligan is \$5.00 or \$10.00 each. All of the funds goes towards your organization or charity.

VEGAS HOLE

A Vegas hole is not only a proximity contest but also a fun way to create additional revenue for your event. On a par three hole a circle is placed around the hole on the putting green. Players can wager from \$1 to \$20 on hitting their ball within the circle. If the golf ball lands within the circle, they double their wager. If the golf ball lands on the green but not in the circle, they get the wager back. If they miss the green they have just donated to your tournament. On average 3% hit the ball in the circle, 45% hit the green and 52% donate to your event. This type of contest requires two volunteers to collect wagers and to run the contest.

50/50 HOLE

A 50/50 hole is set up on a par three for a designated fee. Player purchases an opportunity to land on the green and receive a raffle ticket. At the conclusion of the event one ticket is drawn from the participants and they win half of the pot. The remaining 50% goes into the tournament fund.

RAFFLE

Golfers buy raffle tickets throughout the day in hopes of winning prizes that have been donated by your tournament supporters. At the awards presentation tickets are drawn for each prize being raffled off, designating a winner. All of the funds collected from the raffle tickets are a donation to your tournament.

AUCTION

Auctions, both live and silent a great ways to generate funds for your tournament. Players can bid on donated items and the winner of the item is the highest bidder. Funds collected from the auction winners is considered a donation to your event.

TOURNAMENT BEVERAGES

Eagle Springs Golf & Country Club provides Beverage Cart Service for tournament play.

DRINK TICKETS

Drink tickets are \$4.00 each; you can predetermine an amount to be equally distributed to your players. Drink ticket is good for a soft drink, import or domestic beer. Drink tickets are good only on the day of the tournament.

HOST BEVERAGE CART

Events have the opportunity to host the beverage cart for their golfers for a set dollar amount. Eagle Springs will track the consumption and calculate a beverage total at the conclusion of the tournament. (An 18% gratuity will be added to the final billing)

CUSTOM HOST

Tournaments have the ability to customize hosted beverage service for their players. You may host a Bar and/or Beverage Cart Beverage with Beer, Wine, Soft Drinks and Hard Alcohol. Your package can be at a set dollar amount or for a set period of time. (Please let us know what provisions that you would like to accommodate for your players and we can make the necessary arrangements.)

DIRECTIONS

FROM THE SOUTH

- Take Freeway 99 North and exit on Freeway 41 North
- Exit onto Friant Road going north
- Proceed on Friant Road 16 miles (Friant Road will turn into Millerton Rd)
- Turn Right on Brighton Crest Drive and proceed to the ESGCC Clubhouse

FROM THE NORTH

- Take Freeway 99 South towards Madera
- Exit on Cleveland Avenue and proceed to Highway 145
- Take Highway 145 East for 19 miles and turn right on Road 206
- Take Road 206 and turn left on Millerton Rd
- Turn Right on Brighton Crest Drive and proceed to the ESGCC Clubhouse
